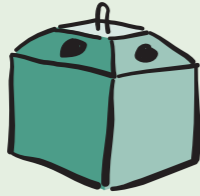


Glass Bin



- Glass medicine bottles (empty)
- Glass cream jars
- Glass bottles for juice, champagne, liquors, wine (not returnable)
- Beer bottles (not returnable)
- Glass vinegar bottles
- Glass jars for baby food
- Glass jars for fruit or vegetables
- Glass spice jars
- Glass pickle jars
- Glass honey jars
- other Glass food jars
- Glass ketchup bottles
- Glass perfume bottles
- Glass mustard jars and bottles
- Glass shampoo bottles
- Glass cooking oil bottles
- Drinking glasses



! Clear, brown and green glass are collected separately. Glass of different colour (e.g. blue glass) must be thrown into the green compartment.

Examples

➤ **bring back to the store:** returnable bottles

➤ **into Grey Garbage Can:** Mirrors, crystal, light bulbs, porcelain, pottery, stoneware, window glass (small amounts)

➤ **to Hazardous Waste Collection:** Florescent light bulbs

➤ **to Construction Waste Disposal Facility:** ceramic sanitary ware, large amounts of window or mirror glass

Can/Aluminum Bin



- Aluminium lids
- Aluminum foil
- Aluminium trays
- Cans made of tinfoil or aluminium
- Paint or varnish tins (completely empty)
- Paint buckets made of tinfoil (completely empty)
- Beer cans
- Coffee cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Food cans
- Frozen food trays
- Juice cans
- Metal caps
- Pie tins
- Soda cans (not returnable)
- Pet food cans made of tinfoil or aluminium



Examples

! Metallic or aluminium wrapping may also be put into the Yellow Bag.

➤ **bring back to the store:** returnable cans

➤ **into the Scrap Metal Bin :** metal or aluminium parts which are not wrapping (e.g. small amounts of cables, iron tubes, pans and pots)

➤ **into the Yellow Bag:** vacuum packaging for coffee

➤ **to the scrap dealer or scrapyards:** car parts, motorbikes and mopeds

Organic Waste Can

From the kitchen

- All organic food leftovers
- Bones
- Coffee filters
- Eggshells and nutshells
- Kitchen paper
- Table scraps
- Tea bags
- Vegetable waste
- Wet paper and paper bags (small amounts)



Examples

From the garden

- Dead flowers
- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Plants
- Small tree branches
- Weeds

From the house

- Feathers, hair
- Saw dust
- Kleenex, paper napkins
- Paperboard (small amounts)
- Dirty or greasy paper

Use only paper bags for collection of organic waste. No plastic bags. Do not use the Organic Waste Can (Biotonne) for your regular trash.



Into Grey Garbage Can:

Ashes, cat litter, cigarette butts, disposable diapers, sidewalk sweepings, vacuum cleaner bags

Paper Can

- Adding machine tape
- Advertisements
- Cardboard
- Cereal and food item boxes
- Coloured paper
- Computer paper
- Copier paper
- Envelopes
- Gift wrapping paper
- Index cards
- Junk mail
- Legal pads
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Paper bags
- Paper egg cartons
- Post-it-notes
- Telephone books
- White paper



Bulky cardboard packaging and surplus waste paper can be deposited at your municipal Recycling Centre (Wertstoffsammelstelle) and at the Kitzingen Wertstoffhof (max. 1 cubic metre per month).

Examples



Into Grey Garbage Can:

Carbon paper, disposable diapers, photo paper, wallpaper, wax paper

Into Organic Waste Can:

butcher's or baker's paper bags, dirty or greasy paper, Kleenex, paper napkins

into Yellow Bag:

Juice cartons, milk cartons, plastic coated cardboard

Yellow Bag



Plastic packaging

- Plastic bags
- Plastic bottles
- Plastic bottle caps
- Plastic containers, i.e. yogurt, butter
- Plastic detergent and shampoo bottles
- Plastic drinking cups
- Plastic freezer and sandwich bags
- Plastic plates
- Plastic trays
- Plastic wrap



Examples

Mixed / layered packaging

- Milk or juice cartons (Tetrapak)
- Vacuum sealed wrapping for coffee, etc.

Styrofoam packaging

- Styrofoam containers
- Styrofoam meat trays
- Styrofoam packaging materials

Metal or aluminium packaging

- Aluminium lids, foils or trays
- Tinplate or aluminium cans (e.g. not returnable beverage cans, biscuit tins, cans of tinned food, milk cans, empty aerosol cans, pet food cans)
- Paint or varnish tins (completely empty)
- Paint buckets made of tinplate (completely empty)
- Metal crown caps
- Aluminium foil chocolate packaging
- Metal Screw-caps

All packaging materials made of metal or aluminium may also be put into the Can/Aluminium Bin.

Garbage Can

- Ashes
- Audio and video tapes
- Broken china
- Brushes and combs
- Cans with dried paint or glue leftover
- Carbon paper
- Cat litter
- Cigarette butts
- Clothes and shoes (unusable)
- Crystal
- Disposable diapers
- House pet litter
- Leather and rubber
- Light bulbs
- Mirrors
- Photo paper
- (Plastic) toys
- Plastic sausage casings
- Lever arch files, ring binders
- Sidewalk sweepings
- Stationery (e.g. pencils, biros, markers, labels, stickers, etc.)
- Stoneware and pottery
- Tampons, sanitary pads, condoms
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Wallpaper
- Wax paper
- Window glass (small amounts)



Examples

Never put electric appliances or electronic devices into the Grey Garbage Can! Use cost free drop-off at your municipal Recycling Centre (Wertstoffsammelstelle)!
